WARM-UP QUESTIONS:

1. Who was your favorite “teacher” (school or otherwise)? How did they make such an impact on you?
2. Share something you’ve learned recently. It could be a fact, a lesson, maybe a way to think about something.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

1. Read through the creation accounts in Genesis 2 and 3. Pastor Jason draws out three insights on God teaches us - through wonder, instruction, and discipline. Which one comes most naturally to you? Which is more of a challenge?
2. Reflecting on the Revelation 3 passage, what is the current temperature of your heart toward God at - ranging from hot to lukewarm to cold? What has contributed to your personal assessment? How might God’s teaching moments toward you (through wonder, instruction, and discipline) be a timely and appropriate expression of love for you?
3. How might God’s willingness to teach us be considered a necessary expression of divine love?

APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

1. How have you best heard and learned from God - through your personal reading of the Bible, through solitude and silence, through discernment with others, through other means and uses of your faculties? What is something that you are seeking God to teach you? How can you be prepared to receive what God has in store for you? How can your small group support you in this?
2. Thinking back to important times of self reflection and deeper insights, how did they connect you more to God, God’s love, desires and purposes? How can you remain receptive during this season of your life?
