Title: Crossing Jordan "Servants"

Text: Joshua 1:10-15 Date: June 27, 2021

WARM-UP QUESTIONS:

- 1. Thinking back, what was the most difficult transition you ever faced (moving away from home, going to college, getting married, starting a new job)? What were your thoughts and feelings right before it happened? How did you feel afterwards?
- 2. Imagine yourself at the brink of Jordan receiving the message of getting ready to cross. What would you gather in those three days? How would you get yourself and your family ready for the crossing?
- 3. What are your feelings at this point of this pandemic? What positive (and negative) things have you picked up along the way?

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Read through the Joshua passage several times. What must it be like to have one's first "glimpse" (albeit through the eyes of others) of what is to come?
- 2. Examine other examples in the Bible of the 'three days' period through the stories of Abraham, Moses, Esther, Jonah, Jesus, etc. What was going on in their lives? What were they preparing for? How were they before and after the preparation periods? What were they called to do after those three days? What can we learn from them?

APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

- 1. What was your 'three days' period during this pandemic? What did God teach you during that time?
- 2. What did you learn from this pandemic that may prepare you for the new life after the pandemic? For the future disaster? How can your bad days prove that God is good?
- 3. How may God be calling you to serve as a leader or volunteer for the services of the church? How may you better support the leaders of our church in all their endeavors?
