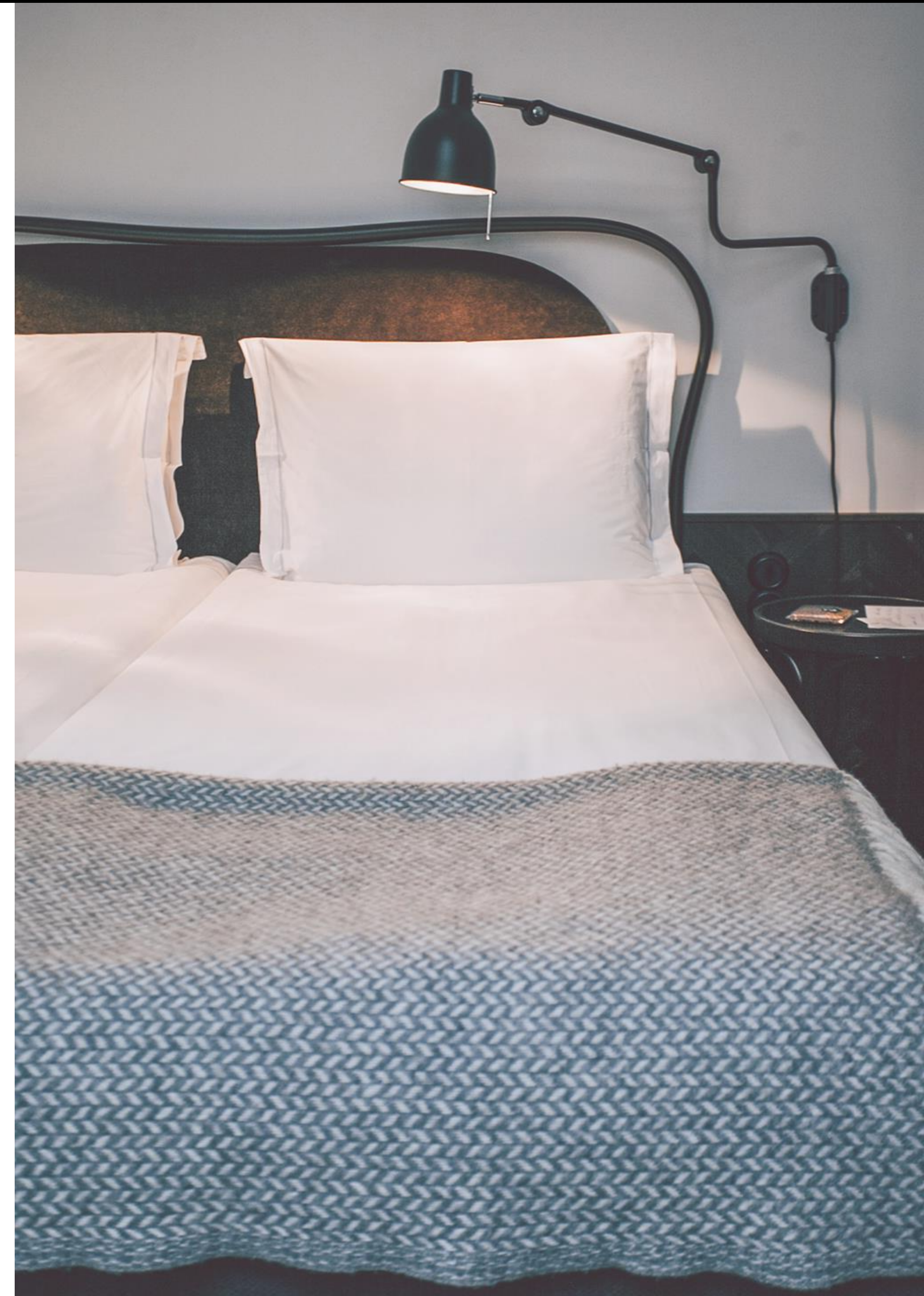
<sup>22</sup> And one thing more: Prepare a guest room for me, because I hope to be restored to you in answer to your prayers.

<sup>25</sup> The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit.

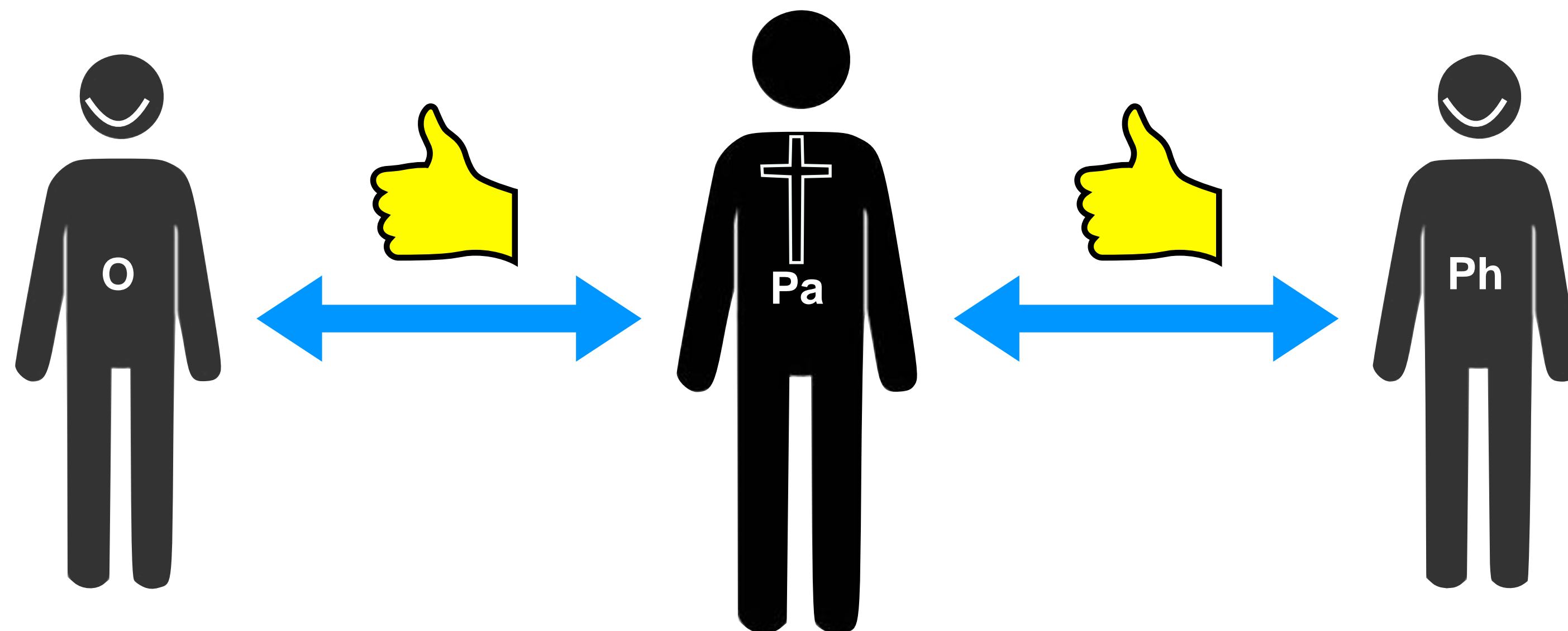

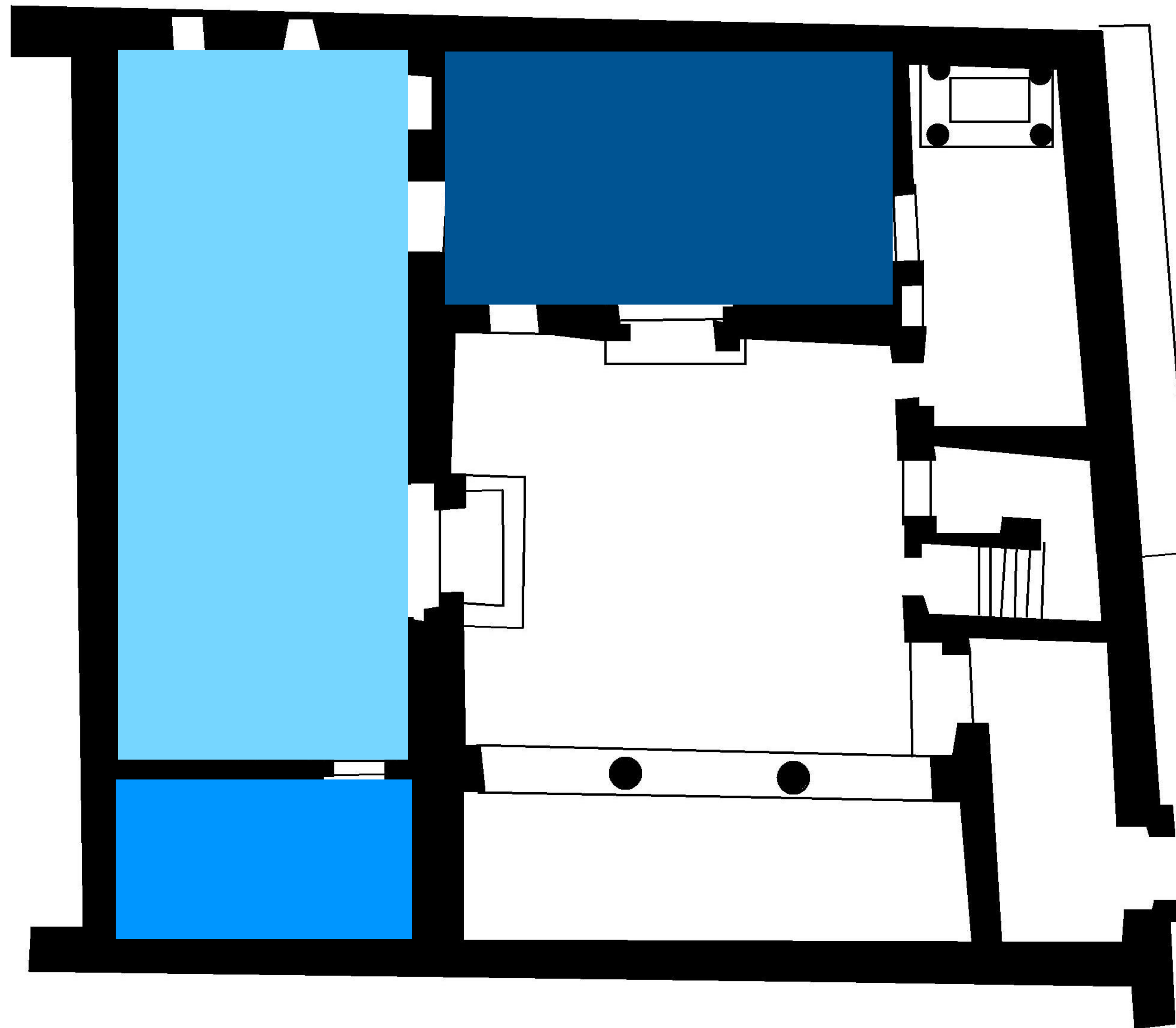

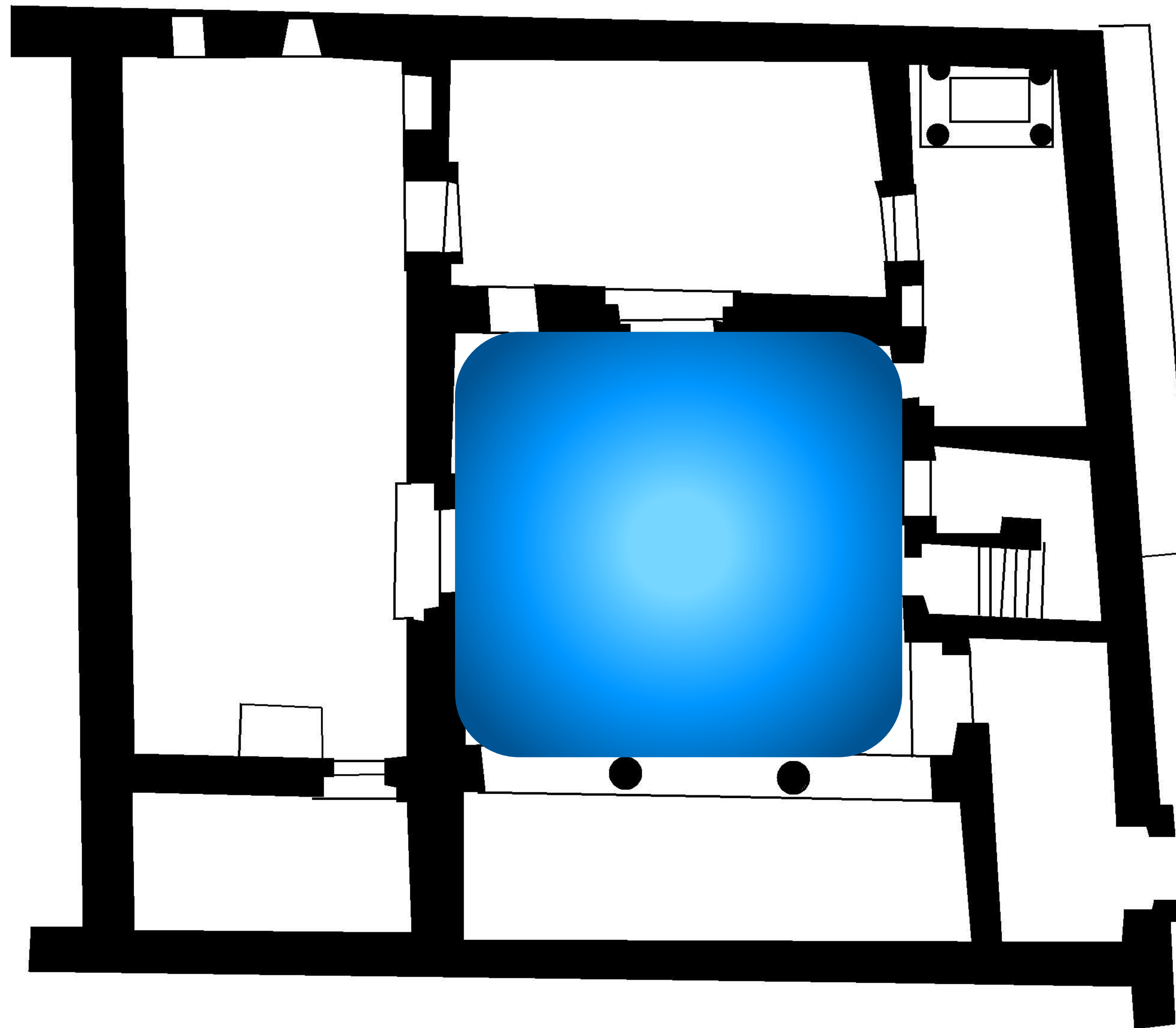
